Reservations are on a first come, first serve basis and will fill very fast. Unpaid reservations cannot be accepted. After October 9, any unsold seats may be reserved and paid for at the October 16 luncheon.

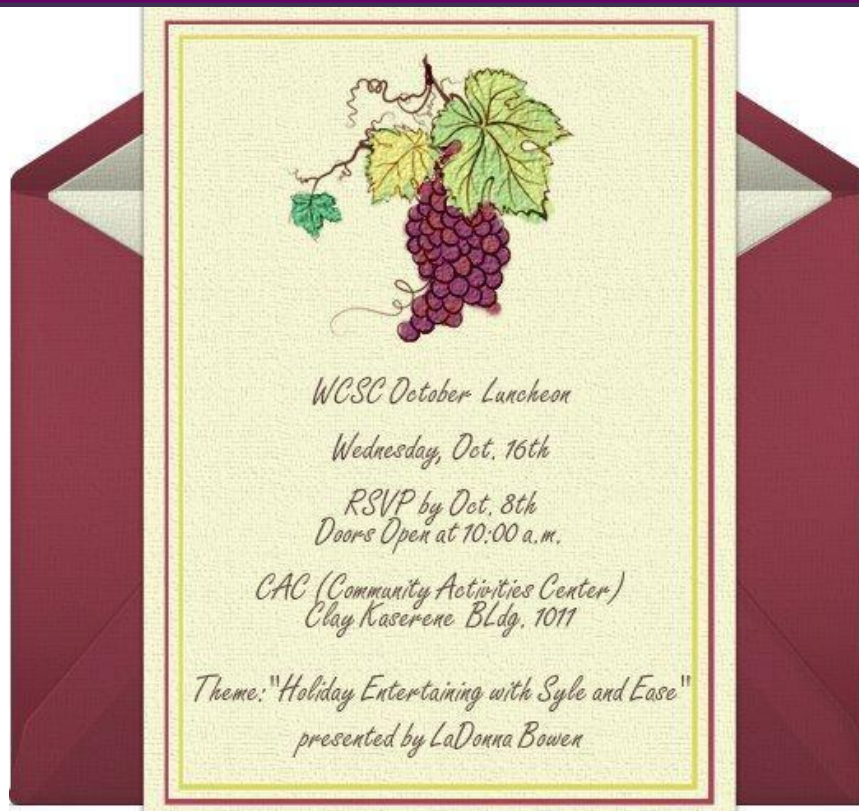
Oct 24 - Book Club
